- Confessions** - Thirty minutes before weekend Masses.

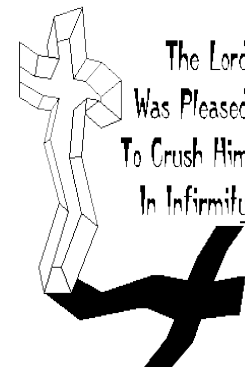
