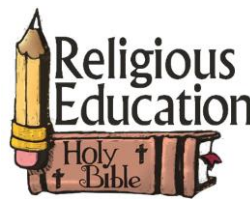

2019 MASS BOOK

The Mass Book for 2019 opened on **Monday, May 7, 2018**. We will continue with the changes from last year, and we ask for your continued patience, understanding, and cooperation. Due to the fact that after our merger we lost 300+ Masses per year and our Mass book filled very quickly, we are limiting the number of Masses you may purchase per household. Each household will only be allowed to reserve **2 weekend Masses and 3 weekday Masses when the book opens**. If Masses are available after August 1, 2018, each household may reserve 2 more weekend and 3 more weekday Masses. We would like to keep this policy to allow as many people as possible to reserve Masses and not sell out a year ahead of time. We ask that you also consider the options of our Memorial Book and sanctuary candles in lieu of a Mass. Thank you for your cooperation.
