Missed Sunday Mass? Please remember to make up your envelopes for the Sunday(s) you missed. The offertory collections for the past 4 Sundays are up \$1,598.00, +9%, \$399.00 more each week. Our income drops during the summer, Fewer people are in church and people do not make up their envelopes for the times they are not here on a Sunday. We count on your support for all the 52 Sundays of the year. We value your sacrificial giving.

We hope that more of our members giving \$1-\$6 will increase their amount to at least \$7+. We know that what you give each

Sunday is your personal decision. However, you might want to ask yourself this question: "When was the last time I increased my Sunday offering...2, 5, 7, 10, 15, 20 years ago, never?" What you give on a Sunday should not be some cold number buried in cement. It should be an amount that is a percent of your income which can go up and down depending on your income. The reality is that we are not receiving enough income to pay our bills. Imagine if you did not earn enough to pay your bills at home. Your parish cannot pay its bills. Please, will you look at what you earn each week and raise your donation to at least 2% of your weekly income? We need to pay our/your church bills.

New in the parish? Please come to the sacristy or ask an usher for one of our special blue envelopes for parishioners who want to register in our parish. Remember to include your cell phone number and/or your email so we can contact you. Our goal is to have all our parishioners using church envelopes for their contributions. **Our pastor and group representatives have suggested a tithe of 2%, 2 cents from each dollar you earn for the parish and the other 98 cents for your family.** Below is a chart with the details:

**At an Open Meeting, parishioners present suggested we begin the table above with an income that reflects the NYC minimum wage of \$8.75 per hr. The first weekly income on your envelope is now \$350.00 weekly, \$18,200.00 yearly. The 2% tithe on a week's minimum wage is \$7.00 weekly, \$364.00 yearly. God loves a generous giver.*

Love, Justice, and Housework {Luke 10:38-42} - In the Gospel Reading, Martha is trying to feed Jesus and his disciples. Even if Jesus came with only his twelve apostles, that still makes lunch for 13. With a modern kitchen, lunch for so many is not easy to prepare. I have no idea how Martha could manage it with whatever kitchen she had. And it's worse for her because she is stuck doing it by herself. **Her sister Mary is sitting on the floor by Jesus, listening to him. How unjust to Martha is that?** So, no wonder Martha nudges Jesus and insists that he tell Mary to get a move on—into the kitchen, helping with housework. Fair is fair! Jesus is supposed to be the greatest upholder of justice. Fairness to women should be part of his concern, too, shouldn't it? Where is the fairness to Martha in Jesus' being an enabler of Mary's failure to help in the kitchen?



But fairness to Mary is precisely what Jesus is protecting by refusing to send Lunch her into the kitchen, isn't it? The best thing in the world is to be by Jesus, to love him, to learn from him, to give yourself to him. And Jesus will not let lunch take that best thing away from Mary. What justice would there be if he did? Does the need for housework trump a person's desire to be by the Lord and learn from him? But, you might say, what about Martha? Where is the fairness for Martha here? And what if Martha had wanted to sit by the Lord, too. Then what would have happened to lunch?

But think about it. Is there really no other way that lunch could have gotten on the table, without forcing Mary (or Mary and Martha) away from the Lord? **Couldn't some of those male disciples have made lunch, for example?** For that matter, couldn't the Lord who fed the five thousand miraculously have managed to feed a mere

dozen or so in the same way? As far as that goes, what's wrong with their all fasting on this occasion? *Eleonore Stump, Professor of Philosophy at St. Louis University*

Photography is a great hobby. People love to take pictures. Imagine that a friend would like to take your picture. She asks you to smile. She holds the camera facing toward you and snaps the photo. Are you sure she got a very good picture of yourself? You don't think so. You did not like the way she was focusing the camera. You look at the digital photo. She had the camera out of focus. You were right. She tries again and the results are much better this time.

When taking pictures, it is very important to make sure you are **focused on the right thing.** It was pretty foolish for her to try to take your picture with the camera out of focus. In our daily life, it is important that we try to focus on the right things too. Sometimes, we forget what is important and we focus on all the wrong things. That is what our Bible lesson teaches us today.

One day, Jesus went to visit in the home of two sisters named Mary and Martha. The sisters welcomed Jesus into their home and Martha immediately began to work very hard to get dinner ready for Jesus. While Martha worked to prepare the meal, Mary just sat at the feet of Jesus and listened to his teaching. Martha was upset that her sister was not helping her, so she went to Jesus and complained, "Can't you see that my sister is not helping me? Don't you even care? Tell her to help me."



Jesus answered, "Martha, Martha, you are worried and troubled about too many things. Only a few things are important, perhaps just one. Mary has chosen that one thing and I will not take it away from her." Martha made the mistake of focusing on herself rather than on Jesus. Mary, on the other hand, was totally focused upon Jesus and what he was teaching. Jesus said that she had chosen the right thing.

As you live your daily life, you can be worried and troubled about many things that are not really important. Are you focused on Jesus, the one thing that is really important? Heavenly Father, help us to keep our focus on Jesus each and every day. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.

Dare to dream Pope Francis has encouraged Argentinians. The first Argentine Pontiff in history stressed this in a letter he sent Friday to the President of the Argentinian Episcopal Conference, José María Arancedo, on the occasion of the 200th anniversary of the country's independence. "Only if our elderly dare to dream and our young imagine great things," Francis stressed, "Can the Homeland be free?" We need elderly people who dream and motivate young people, who in turn run forth armed with the creativity of imagination, inspired by these very dreams."

Addressing the nation's people and authorities, he expressed his hope "that this celebration will make us stronger in the path taken by our ancestors two hundred years ago."

Francis also didn't shy away from urging them to "not to sell the Motherland" and to resist "all forms of colonization". The Holy Father also acknowledged those suffering in the South American nation, especially the poor, sick, lonely, unemployed, incarcerated, and those who are victims of abuses, such as trafficking and exploitation.



Looking ahead to a better future, he highlighted, "I would like to ask the elderly, who have a good memory of history, to look past this throwaway culture that has been forced upon us and dare to

dream. We need their dreams, they are a fount of inspiration." "I ask young people," he said, "not to live a retired life in a bureaucratic quietism they are encouraged into by many opportunities that lack excitement and heroism." Pope Francis concluded reminding his nation's people to never stop dreaming.

From our pastor - Last Sunday's offertory collection 7/10/16 was \$5,512.00 **Thank You!** There were 439 envelopes containing cash and checks which made up 82% all the money in the collection; the other 18% was from parishioners who chose to use loose bills in the collection.

Dropping a dollar bill loose in the collection or in an envelope indicates that you have an income of \$50.00 a week. Who can live on \$50.00 a week? Think about it! What you contribute on a Sunday should be 2% of your income. \$1 in the collection indicates you earn \$50.00 a week, and \$2.00 indicates you earn \$100 a week, \$3.00 you earn \$150.00 a week, \$4.00 you earn \$200.00 a week and \$5.00 you earn \$250.00 a week.

Please look at your weekly income and see if the money you give loose or in your envelope represents 2% of your weekly income. If it doesn't, you might ask yourself "Why?" Why don't I want to give a 2% tithe? What is stopping me from doing it? Maybe you might pray over it and ask Christ to help you become a generous giver of your time, talents and treasure.

Thank you all for your generosity. On Sunday, July 10th, the average donation of parishioners giving \$1.00 - \$6.00 was \$4.12 and \$17.09 for those giving \$7.00 - \$100.00. There were 429 envelopes from the 3 Masses. Parishioners giving \$1.00 - \$6.00 accounted for 52% of all envelopes but only 22% of the money in all the envelopes. Parishioners giving \$7.00 - \$100.00 accounted for 49% of all envelopes and 78% of all the money in all the envelopes. Almost half/ 232 of our parishioners are giving \$1-\$6. They make up only 22% of the money in the Sunday collection. **Please give some thought to increasing your donation to \$7.00**

*****140 parishioners last Sunday** gave the most popular but not the most helpful amount of \$5.00. Their 140 envelopes made up 36% of our Sunday donors, but only gave 16% of the money in the Collection. If \$5.00 is 2% of your actual weekly income, it indicates you are earning only \$250.00 a week, about \$1,083.00 a month, \$13,000.00 a year. We hope this is a miscalculation.

The current lowest wage in NYC is \$8.75 per hour, \$350.00 a week. Living on \$250.00 a week would be next to impossible in our neighborhood, to pay rent, gas, electric, food, cell phone, laundry, Lotto, the subway/bus, etc. with an income of \$1,000.00 a month, without outside help.

We ask our parishioners who have been giving the same amount of \$5.00 for years, to consider at the least, raising their \$5.00 donation to \$7.00 which is 2% of NYC minimum wage of \$8.75 per hr. and \$350.00 weekly. Our new minimum donation is \$7.00 or 2% of \$350.00. Please consider adding \$2.00 to your current donation of \$5.00 and bring it up to \$7.00. Thank you..

Del Pastor - La Colecta del Domingo pasado, Julio 10, fue \$5,589.00 en 439 sobres con 82% de la colecta en cash, y cheques; el resto de la colecta, 18%, fue dinero suelto de feligreses que no usan sobres. La donación promedio el Domingo 10 de Julio por sobre del ofertorio con feligreses dando \$1.00 - \$6.00 fue \$4.22 y \$15.64 por personas dando \$7.00 a \$100.00. Feligreses dando \$1.00 - \$6.00 tenían 51% de todos los sobres, pero solamente 22% del dinero en todos los sobres. Feligreses dando \$7.00 - \$100.00 tenían 49% de todos los sobres y 78% del dinero en todos los sobres. Casi la mitad [50%] de nuestros miembros estan dando solamente 18% de la colecta.

* **140 de nuestros feligreses el 10 de Julio donaron la cantidad favorita de \$5.00. Los 140 sobres fueron 36% de todos los sobres, pero solamente 16% del dinero en todos los sobres. Si \$5.00 es 2% de su ingreso semanal, esto indica que usted esta ganando \$250.00 semanal, \$13,000.00 al año, \$1,083.00 al mes. El pago mínimo ahora en nuestra ciudad es \$8.75 por hora/\$350.00 semanal.

Esperamos que esto es un error de cálculo por su parte. Sería casi imposible en nuestra vecindad pagar renta, comida, celular, electricidad, gas, lavandería, Lotto, el subway/bus, con \$1,000.00 al mes sin ayuda de otro fuente. Si es así, por favor aumente su donación a \$7 que refleja el pago mínimo de \$8.75 por hora en nuestra ciudad. Servir a Los Hermanos, Siempre {Luke 10: 38-42}

En este décimo sexto domingo del tiempo ordinario la palabra de Dios nos trae la imagen de María de Betania, sentada los pies de Jesús, su maestro, como ejemplo para nosotros, para que entendamos que escuchar la Palabra de Dios, saborearla, meditarla y asimilarla es una tarea valiosa. Seguir a Jesús suponen una atenta escucha de la Palabra de Dios. El relato del libro del Génesis de la primera lectura se relaciona con el evangelio: Abraham brinda hospitalidad a unos forasteros y es recompensado con un hijo; Marta y María hospedan a Jesús, y el Señor las recompensa dándoles el verdadero sentido del discipulado. **El evangelio nos muestra dos formas de seguir a Jesús**, y también nos indica cuál es la más perfecta. A primera vista parece que Jesús reta a Marta por trabajar muchos y elogia a María por no hacer nada. Sin embargo, la Iglesia celebra cada año, el 29 de julio a Marta como Santa, y nos la propone como modelos de los que se dedican a servir en el hogar.

Entonces ¿Qué es lo que critica Jesús en Marta y alaba en María? Marta y María, hermanas de Lázaro, reciben a Jesús en su casa, pero observa San Lucas que mientras Marta “estaba muy ocupada en las tareas de la casa, María, sentada a los pies del Señor, escuchaba su Palabra” En esa época, eran los discípulos quienes se sentaban a los pies de sus maestros. Y María,

aprovecha la oportunidad, para sentarse a los pies de Jesús, para ser su discípula. Y ésta actitud era escandalosa para las costumbres de la época, porque no se admitía, que las mujeres fueran discípulas. En tiempos de Jesús, un



hombres no podía estar hablando públicamente con una mujer, y muchos menos aún enseñarle. Asimismo sólo los varones podían asistir al culto, las mujeres estaban en las casas de oración en lugares apartados y secundarios. A cualquiera que se le hubiera preguntado en ese momento, cuál era el lugar de María, hubiera contestado simplemente: la cocina. Y por eso, porque la situación no era adecuada para la época, Marta le reclama a Jesús que mande a María a ayudarlo.

Y qué hace Jesús? Defiende a María. El Señor reconoce la laboriosidad de Marta. No la reta por ser muy trabajadora. Y tampoco alaba a María, por perezosa. En el evangelio no se hace alusión a que María no trabajase habitualmente, sino sólo destaca que en ese momento, en el momento que Jesús, llega a su casa, y que ella tiene oportunidad de escucharlo y de aprender, entonces en ese momento, en lugar de hacer las tareas de la casa, lo escucha. Marta en cambio, si bien está haciendo algo bueno y valioso, y quiere servir a Jesús de la mejor manera, en realidad se encuentra con una

respuesta del Señor que la desconcierta, el Señor le hace ver, que con tantas preocupaciones no se toma el tiempo para escuchar lo que Jesús le quiere decir.

Las dos hermanas, quieren a Jesús y lo quieren servir,

pero de distinta forma, y el Señor remarca, que hay un tiempo para cada cosa. Y así también debe pasar en nuestra vida. En nuestra vida, tendremos momentos en que tenemos que trabajar y momentos en que tenemos que estar atentos al Señor, dialogar con él, en definitiva hacer ORACION. Hay una frase muy conocida que dice: ORA Y LABORA, ora y trabaja. Cada cosa en su momento oportuno. Pero el que nos se toma suficiente tiempo para la oración y para escuchar la Palabra de Dios, no podrá ser efectivo en su vida cristiana
