At the beginning of January Mike Shaw and Dick Neves will take four checked bags weighing 50 lbs each plus carry-on luggage to our twin parish in Savanette. In those bags will be about 30 lbs of medications, kindly obtained for us at cost by Sen Marimuthu at Blacksburg Pharmacy; bolts of cloth for the sewing center; clothing; water bottles; rosaries; religious medals; soccer balls; school supplies; stuffed animals; dolls and many balloons. **Thank you to those who donated items for this trip.** Photographs of the primary school students will be taken on this trip to use during our tuition sponsorship campaign. This year the campaign will begin in late January, before the season of Lent in 2019. The financial upheaval in Haiti has caused the Haitian gourde to decline in value making it more difficult than ever for families to maintain even a low standard of living at our twin parish. Our support of their education continues to be key for the betterment of these families.
