RENEW AND REBUILD

The Archdiocese has already reached its goal of 200 million dollars pledged for the entire campaign. Our parish goal is \$811,000, the good news is that from less than 100 families we have achieved gifts and pledges amounting to \$665,200.00 or 82% of our goal. A five year pledge to this campaign from our remaining families can put us to fund the projects that we envisioned for the campaign. These projects include the new organ, a new roof and AC for the Church and School, a newly milled and re-paved parking lot, two bathrooms for our parish meeting room, refurbished front door, reupholstered kneelers, a renovated sacristy and church storage area, and live streaming from the church to the entrance, classroom and auditorium.
