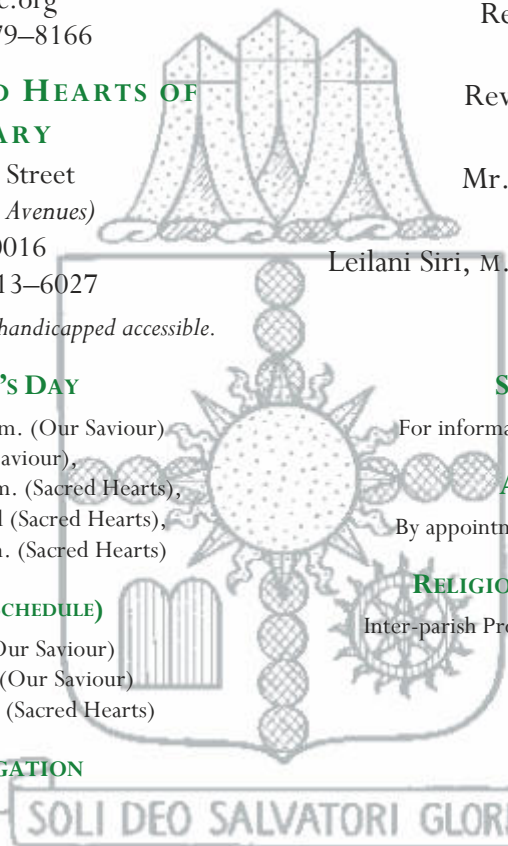

### A PRAYER FOR OUR GOVERNMENT

**W**e pray you, O God of might, wisdom, and justice, through whom authority is rightly administered, laws are enacted, and judgment decreed, assist with your Holy Spirit of counsel and fortitude the President of these United States, that his administration may be conducted in righteousness, and be eminently useful to your people, over whom he presides; by encouraging due respect for virtue and religion; by a faithful execution of the laws in justice and mercy; and by restraining vice and immorality. Let the light of your divine wisdom direct the deliberations of Congress, and shine forth in all the proceedings and laws framed for our rule and government, so that they may tend to the preservation of peace, the promotion of national happiness, the increase of industry, sobriety, and useful knowledge; and may perpetuate to us the blessing of equal liberty.

We recommend likewise, to your unbounded mercy, all our fellow citizens throughout the United States, that we may be blessed in the knowledge and sanctified in the observance of your most holy law; that we may be preserved in union, and in that peace which the world cannot give; and after enjoying the blessings of this life, be admitted to those which are eternal.

## SAINT MARIA GORETTI – 6 JULY



This young martyr was born in 1890 to poor farmers in Italy. After her father's death, Maria was in charge of the household while her mother worked the fields. When she was alone at age 11, a young man named Alessandro, a neighbor, tried to rape Maria. She resisted, and he stabbed her several times and then fled. On her deathbed, she mercifully forgave Alessandro and hoped God would as well. Alessandro was sentenced to prison, where he expressed remorse after Maria appeared to him in a dream with a bouquet of lilies.
