Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jubilee Year of Mercy

“You fool, this night your life will be demanded of you” (Luke 12:20). Hardly sounds like mercy! Unlike some contemporary rich folks, there is no indication of lying, stealing, or cheating in Jesus’ parable. The rich man made a living, not a killing. Why does Jesus name him “fool”? First, because of presumption. Five times in nine verses, the rich man declares, “I shall.” God’s not in charge here, I am! Second, selfishness—four times, “my/myself.” No God, no neighbor; he talks to himself, about himself: *my* possessions, *my* productivity, *my* plans! So, instead of chasing “treasure for ourselves,” Jesus and Pope Francis’ *Jubilee Year of Mercy* bid us grow “rich in what matters to God” (12:21), namely, the corporal and spiritual works of mercy. Give food, drink, clothing, and healing; visit the imprisoned; bury the dead. Heal with Jesus’ own gentleness the doubt, ignorance, and sins of others; comfort, forgive, be patient; and pray for the living and dead.

Stations of Mercy at the Christ Cathedral Campus

On May 17, Bishop Kevin Vann blessed the Stations of Mercy, a permanent installation on the Christ Cathedral campus. The Stations of Mercy, like the Stations of the Cross, are a form of walking meditation. In this special Jubilee Year of Mercy, all are invited to walk the journey of the Stations of Mercy in person.

The Stations of Mercy are based on the Spiritual and Corporal Works of Mercy as described by Pope Francis in his letter, *Misericordiae Vultus* (The Face of Mercy), declaring this Jubilee Year of Mercy. There are eleven Stations of Mercy on the Christ Cathedral campus. Although they are numbered, they can be “walked” and prayed in any order.

- + Do as many stations as you wish; this may be determined by health, time or other factors.
- + Walk them alone or in a group.
- + Use the prayers provided or your own prayers.
- + It is fitting to begin or end your pilgrimage with a visit to the Blessed Sacrament Chapel located in the Small Gallery at the west end of the building.
- + Guides in English, Spanish and Vietnamese are available in the Cultural Center lobby.

Pope Francis writes, “Mercy is the bridge that connects God and humanity, opening our hearts to the hope of being loved forever despite our sinfulness.” Through the grace of our merciful Father, may these Stations of Mercy be places where hearts are opened and mercy is found.

This **Thursday, August 4**, the Catechumens, Candidates and Inquirers will take a tour of the church and sacristy. Please meet in the Church at 7:30. Any parishioners who would like to join us are welcomed. We will not hold RCIA sessions on **August 11** because of the Ministry Center cleaning.

Anyone desiring to become a Catholic is welcome to begin the Inquiry Process on Thursday evenings at 7:30. Inquiry sessions are available year-round, except for holidays, and new participants are welcome at any time. Whether you have decided to become a Catholic, wish to learn more about the Church, or just have questions that you would like to discuss, we encourage you to join us. There is no obligation at this stage of the RCIA process, but for those who desire to continue to the reception of sacraments, the process usually takes a minimum of one year.

Mystery of God

A new Adult Faith Formation series will begin on **Wednesday evening, August 17**, using Bishop Robert Barron's DVD presentations, *The Mystery of God*. In this series he uses insights from St. Augustine, Thomas of Aquinas, Pope Benedict XVI and others to present a clear understanding of what we mean by God. Bishop Barron provides methods for Christians to respond to the New Atheism which is becoming so prevalent in today's secular society. In our gatherings from 7:30 to 9 p.m. we will view his video presentation and have a discussion on his themes. We will meet in the Ministry Center Library.

Monday Morning Bible Study

Our Monday Morning group is on hiatus for the summer. We will resume on **September 12**, with a study of the Book of Acts. Please watch the bulletin for future details.

What was happening in the Ninth Century?

The controversial Photios was one of the most interesting figures of the ninth century. He was born in Constantinople around the year 810 to a well-established family. His paternal great uncle, Tarasios, had been the Patriarch of Constantinople from 784 to 806 under two Byzantine Emperors, Irene and Nikiphoros. The family had been persecuted during the iconoclastic controversies, because Photios' father was a strong devotee of icons, but peace and their position in society was restored by 842 when the controversy was ended.

As a young man, Photios considered becoming a monk, but instead became a scholar and statesman. As discussed last week, in 858 Byzantine Emperor Michael III appointed Photios as Patriarch of Constantinople in place of Ignatius whom Michael had deposed. This appointment was not recognized by Pope Nicholas, who managed to get Ignatius returned to his throne. After Ignatius' death, Photios returned as Patriarch of Constantinople with the approval of the new Roman Pope John VIII.

Beyond the controversy over the Patriarchy, Photios was involved in a great number of political intrigues within the Byzantine Court.

Through his brother's marriage, he was related to Empress Theodora, widow of Emperor Theophilus and mother of Emperor Michael III, for whom she served as regent from 842 to 855. At her court, Photios held the position of Chief Imperial Secretary. Keep in mind that the real meaning of "secretary" has nothing to do with office procedures, but actually means "the person who keeps the secrets." But, beyond all the complications of the Byzantine court of this period, Photios was to become one of the greatest Eastern theologians and scholars since St. John Chrysostom. In addition to his own writings on numerous subjects, Photios established a library with manuscripts of nearly 300 of the Eastern Church Fathers. In many cases, the manuscripts retained by Photios are the only extant copies of these works left for today's church.

He was also significant in spreading the faith to the Slavic peoples. In the 860s, Prince Rastislav of Moravia sent a request to Emperor Michael III and Patriarch Photios for Christian missionaries who could speak the native language of the people. Previous evangelization by Latin speaking missionaries had proved unfruitful. Chosen by Photios for this mission were two biological brothers, named Cyril and Methodius. The brothers had grown up in Thessalonica where there was a large population of Slavs. Cyril had already developed an alphabet for this language and the brothers had translated liturgical books using this alphabet. This written language became known as Old Church Slavonic and was approved by the Pope for liturgical use in Slavic speaking areas. After simplification of the alphabet by Cyril's students, it was called by his own name—the *Cyrillic* alphabet.

Although they had participated in some earlier missionary activities, in 862 the brothers received the commission of Patriarch Photios to evangelize the Slavs. The motivation of the mission from the viewpoint of Emperor Michael III and Prince Rastislav had political overtones, they wished to unite their territories through a common religion, but Cyril and Methodius were true missionaries of the Lord sometimes encountering persecution for their preaching. By 863, Cyril began a translation of the Bible into Old Church Slavonic and went to Greater Moravia to promote it. They were successful in attracting converts, though some Germanic Christians in the area opposed the use of the Slavonic language for liturgy and Scripture.

Pope Nicholas I invited the brothers to meet with him in Rome, when they arrived in 868, Nicholas I had died. They were received by Pope Adrian II with great praise for their work. Methodius and five of their fellow missionaries were ordained priests in Rome by Pope Adrian II. Cyril entered a monastery where he died on February 14, 869. After his brother's death, Methodius returned to his missionary work in Pannonia and Bulgaria. Adrian II consecrated him as Archbishop of Sirmium with authority over Pannonia, Moravia and Serbia. Methodius continued to have conflicts with the Germanic clerics, but was supported by the Pope. He died on April 6, 885, at the age of 70.

And, so, the history of the Church continues.

“¡Insensato! Esta misma noche vas a morir” (Lucas 12:20). ¡Esto no suena misericordioso! En esta parábola de Jesús, a diferencia de algunas personas ricas de estos tiempos, no hay mención de mentir, robar o engañar. El hombre rico se ganaba la vida, no es un asesino. ¿Qué es lo que Jesús le quiere decir por “insensato”? Primero, por arrogante. El hombre rico diciendo lo que va a hacer. Dios no está a cargo de la situación sino el hombre rico. Segundo, por egoísta. No hay mención de Dios, del prójimo; él hombre rico se habla así mismo de él mismo: *¡mis posesiones, mi productividad, mis planes!* Así que en lugar de desear “abundancia de bienes” para nosotros; Jesús y el Papa Francisco en este *Año Jubilar de la Misericordia* nos proponen crecer en aquello que “vale ante Dios” (12:21), es decir las obras de misericordia corporales y espirituales. Dar de comer, de beber, vestir y sanar; visitar a los prisioneros, enterrar a los muertos. Sanar con la misma gentileza de Jesús la duda, la ignorancia y las culpas de los prójimos, confortar, perdonar, ser paciente y orar por los vivos y los muertos.


