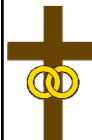

#### Abortion Pricing

The average cost of a first trimester **surgical abortion** in the U.S. is **\$594.74**, while the average cost of a **medication abortion** is **\$568.50**.

Insurance and financial assistance offered by some abortion clinics can bring the price down significantly. For example, in California, it is very easy to qualify for MediCal, which will pay the total cost of the abortion.

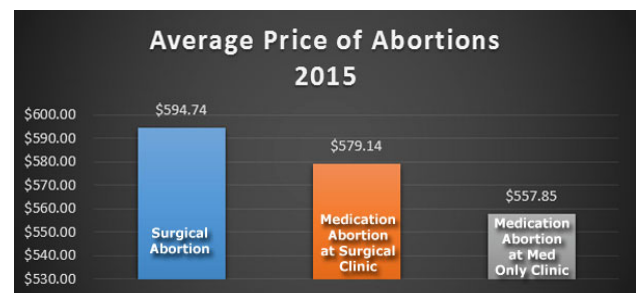
