FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:

In our Gospel this week we hear the "Bread of Life" discourse of Jesus continues. Once again, we hear the Lord telling us that He is the living bread that came down from heaven. With that declaration also comes the promise of eternal life for those who eat this bread. He refers also to those who ate manna in the desert who were satisfied of their physical hunger but ultimately, they died. There was no promise of living forever with the manna. He tells us that whoever eats this bread remains in Him and He in us.

Jesus is present to us in many ways. He is present in each of us, in the community that gathers in His name and in His Word. These are spiritual ways in which He is present. The Eucharist that we receive is often called the "Real Presence" as the Lord comes to us in a physical and tangible way to nourish us for the journey of life. When we receive Communion and the Host is held before us and we hear the "The Body of Christ" our "Amen" should reaffirm our belief in this real presence of Christ. May each of us be renewed in our reverence for the great gift that we receive in the Eucharist—the gift of Jesus Himself

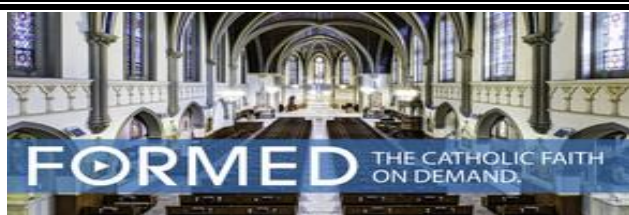
Food Collection Resumes Labor Day Weekend!!
