Dear Parish Family,

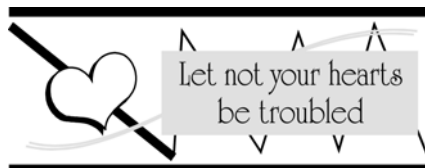
