Pastor's Letter

Dear Parish Family,

We had a successful "Ministry Fair" last weekend due to the efforts of those who volunteered to help, and to Fran Borg, our volunteer business manager, who coordinated all the activities. Thank you all for your service and hard work. Again, I cannot say enough about how elated I was to see so many of our parishioners taking part. If you have not done so already, I again invite everyone to join and participate in any of the various ministries. There are brochures in the pews about our ministries that you can take home. Your participation and involvement are certainly important. This is one way you can put your faith into action.

This weekend Chuck De Meola, our parish accountant and Chairman of the Finance Council, and Chris Leyden, a member of the Finance Council presented the annual financial report to our parish. As most of you may know, our parish financial standing is not as bright as we would like it to be. We continue to conduct a series of renovations to update our parish facilities. I am proud to say that we have accomplished many things in just a few years: installed a new sound system in church, installed a submersible pump in the chapel to avoid flooding, replaced the roofs of our two houses, repaired the church air conditioners, and finally repaired the roof of our church (which is almost done).

Because of your generosity, many of our parish projects have been accomplished. Despite these positive changes, however, St. Andrew's Church, like so many other parishes today, is faced with a serious financial challenge which we must address. You will hear more details in the financial report. As a result, our parish leadership must confront these concerns by moving forward with a concerted effort to increase our Sunday offertory collection and to find other sources of income while cutting expenses. We cannot continue operating on a deficit. So, hopefully, in the coming months, we will come up with a detailed plan on how to meet these financial challenges. I am extremely appreciative of everyone's generosity. I thank you in advance for your ongoing support, understanding and kindness.

We will conduct a training seminar for our "Discovering Christ" team leaders this weekend. I thank Viola Liferi, the over-all Chair, for working so hard and coordinating this activity. To all Discovering Christ team leaders, I thank you for your service and generosity. Please pray for the success of this program which will begin in January, 2018.
