The Solemnity of the Holy Trinity



Trinity Sunday is a moveable feast celebrated a week after Pentecost Sunday. Trinity Sunday honors the most fundamental of Christian beliefs—belief in the Holy Trinity. The fundamental dogma, on which

everything in Christianity is based, is that of the Blessed Trinity in whose name all Christians are baptized. The feast of the Blessed Trinity needs to be understood and celebrated as a prolongation of the mysteries of Christ and as the solemn expression of our faith in this triune life of the Divine Persons, to which we have been given access by Baptism and by the Redemption won for us by Christ.

The human mind can never fully understand the mystery of the Trinity. The dogma of faith which forms the object of the feast is this: There is one God and in this one God there are three Divine Persons; the Father is God, the Son is God, the Holy Spirit is God. Yet there are not three Gods, but one, eternal, incomprehensible God! The Father is not more God than the Son, neither is the Son more God than the Holy Spirit. The Father is the first Divine Person; the Son is the second Divine Person, begotten from the nature of the Father from eternity; the Holy Spirit is the third Divine Person, proceeding from the Father and the Son. Although we cannot fully fathom this sublime truth, we can submit humbly and say: *Lord, I believe, help my weak faith.*
