PARISH MEMBERSHIP

Membership in the parish is important for occasions such as sacramental reception, or when a sponsor certificate (certificate of eligibility) is needed. You can register in the parish by calling the Parish Center (610-867-8409; M-F). **Note: Young adults living on a college campus must obtain sponsor certificates from the church or campus chapel where they attend Mass while away at school.** Any adult 21 years of age or older must be receiving their own envelopes to be considered a member (not considered to be a member under parents membership!).
