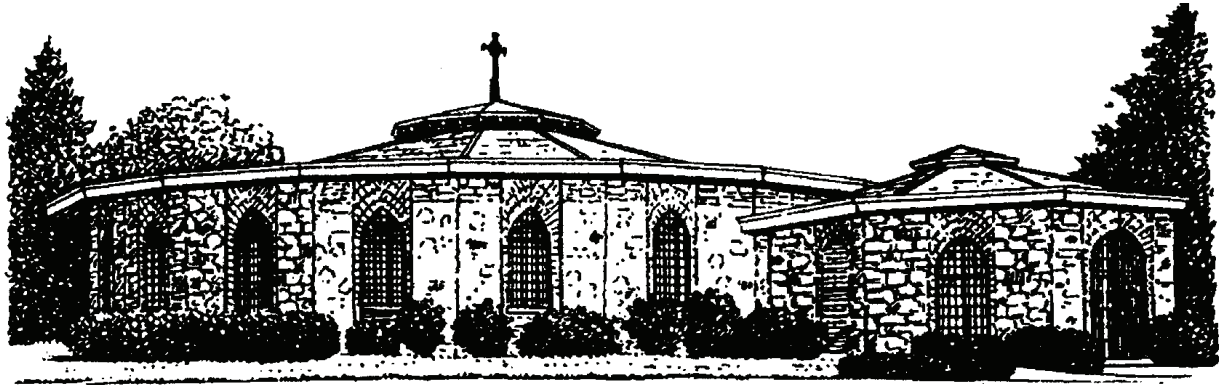

ENOUGH CRUMBS FOR A COOKIE, BUT NOT FOR A MEAL: Every so often, I have information that I would like to share with you, but it is not enough for a full article, but too important for a simple bulletin blurb. Here are some thing that I think are useful to know:

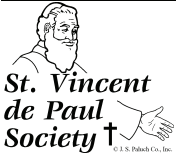
- PARISH ADMINISTRATOR vs. PASTOR: A few people have asked why I am not called the “pastor” of the parish. The answer is that when a priest is put in charge of his first parish, he is made “parish administrator” for the first year, a period during which his suitability is assessed. During this time, he may be removed at any time, if the bishop feels necessary to do so. If the bishops feels that the parish administrator has done well after that year and wishes him to remain in that parish, then he names the priest the “pastor” of the parish. Along with this title come certain rights afforded to him by canon law.
- WHERE’S FATHER GOING?: As you know, I am still working on my doctoral dissertation, so I will be in Rome, October 17-31 to work with my director. Please pray for me, that my work may go well.

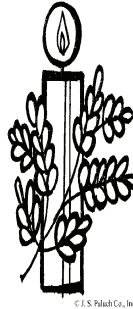
Transfiguration School will be having it's "**Holiday Pie Sale**".
