Somewhere in that tree find a way to show that you are part of God's family, that you are related to Jesus!

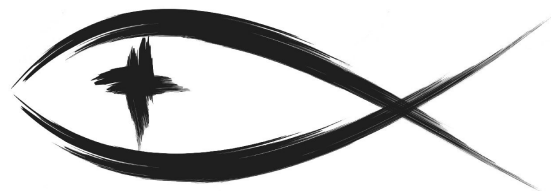
