Ps 101_O General Psychology (3 credits)

This is a basic course in the history, theories, principles, and methods of the psychological study of human behavior. Topics will include a brief history of psychology, critical thinking, human development, motivation, emotion and stress, personality, social psychology, and psychopathology as examined through the biopsychosocial perspective.

Ps 202_O Developmental Psychology (3 credits)

Pre-requisite: Ps 101 or its equivalency (with proper transcript)

This course surveys the physical, intellectual, emotional, and social developmental stages of the human being from conception through aging. This course will examine the genetic, environmental, and socio-cultural influences on development.
