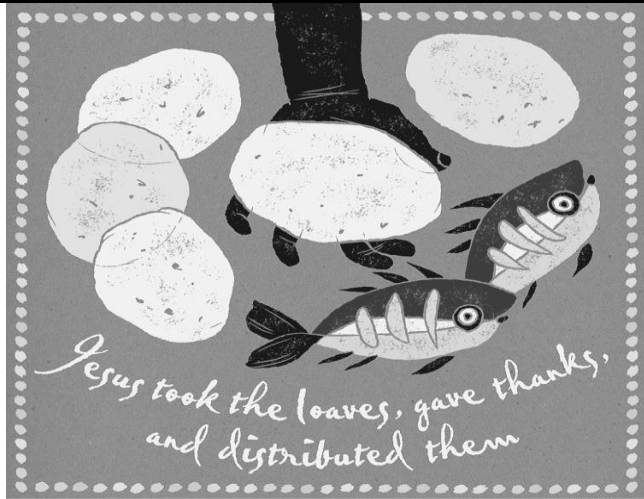

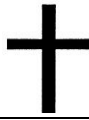
- Prayer in Your Life

“Jesus Christ loves you; he gave his life to save you; and now he is living at your side every day to enlighten, strengthen and free you.” (Pope Francis, Evangelii Gaudium, 164). Would you like to know more? The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the way by which persons experience the love of God through Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist.

Who is RCIA for?

1. Persons in need of Baptism
2. Persons baptized in another Christian tradition who desire to become Catholic
3. Persons baptized Catholic in need of First Communion and/or Confirmation
