



## CYO Chess Lessons at Sts. Philip & James School

Sts. Philip & James Catholic Elementary School is partnering with the Catholic Youth Organization of Long Island to bring Chess to our students. Chess lessons will be available to children in grades 3 thru 8 for those children that are beginners to the game of Chess.

Classes will be held on Saturday mornings at the school from 9am to 10:15am. Parents that want to learn Chess alongside their children are welcome to participate.

Classes will be taught by Sts. Philip & James 6<sup>th</sup> grade teacher Ms. Lori Naso.

Chess lessons will encompass a 10 week session commencing Saturday, March 9<sup>th</sup> at Sts. Philip & James School. The 10 week program costs as follows:

- \$150.00 for the first child in the family
- \$100.00 for each additional sibling
- \$25.00 for a parent that would like to participate.

Chess sets will be provided for the lessons; although it is a good idea for the children to have their own Chess set at home for practice.

The program is subject to a minimum enrollment of 10 children and a maximum enrollment of 20 children.
