As we continue our Lenten journey, let us open ourselves to the invitations which we have before us to come closer to Christ. Saturday evening, February 27th, we have Eucharistic Adoration from 5 to 5:30 pm. At 5:30 pm, we have our Solemn Eucharistic Closing Service with Taize Meditation and Benediction. Make an appointment to adore our Savior, who is present before us in the Blessed Sacrament of the Altar.

We have our Parish Communal Penance Service at 7 pm on Monday, March 7th in our church. We will have extra confessors to hear your confessions. Part of Our Lenten Retreat is for all of us to receive the Sacrament of Penance. In the Gospel of the third Sunday of Lent, Our Blessed Lord calls us to repentance. That word, "Repentance" is linked to the English word, "Pensive" which means thoughtful. To repent means to think again about our lives. The purple color of Lent calls us to a change of heart. During this Year of Mercy, we are called to receive Mercy and to extend Mercy.

We will have our Easter Breakfast and Basket Raffle on Sunday, March 13th from 9 am to 1 pm. Breakfast includes French Toast, Sausage, Scrambled Eggs, Juice, Coffee and Milk. Please plan to attend the breakfast. It is a time for fellowship with our parishioners. The proceeds from the breakfast go to assist our St. Vincent de Paul Society in serving the needs of the poor.

Also on Sunday, March 13th we have a Eucharistic Holy Hour that begins at 12:30 pm. Again, this is a wonderful opportunity to spend time with our Blessed Lord. The Holy Hour includes Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Rosary, Homily, Benediction, the Chaplet of Divine Mercy and Fatima Prayers. Please consider taking advantage of this opportunity.

Holy Week begins with our Palm Sunday Vigil Mass on Saturday, March 19th at 4 pm. Our Palm Sunday Masses are at 9 am and 11 am on Sunday, March 20th.
