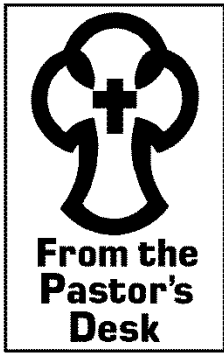

**Godparent and Sponsor Certificate** – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be registered and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. Please note individuals 18 years of age and older, no longer in school, need to register.

We thank Pat Smosarski for the picture of St. John Paul II that we placed by the St. Anthony statue by the back vestibule. He was a great man who touched the lives of many.

I am grateful that he ordained me to the priesthood on June 24, 1979 over the tomb of St. Peter in St. Peter's Basilica in Vatican City State and that my family was there for this happy occasion. St. John Paul II pray for us. May we be blessed by his prayers and example.

This weekend, July 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> will be our Annual Missionary Appeal. Father Phillip Mayfield will be with us this weekend. He is with the Pontifical Institute for Foreign Missions. It is a Catholic Missionary Institute of priests and brothers who commit themselves to lifelong missionary service, especially to Non-Christians. PIME's priority is the proclamation of the Gospel. They are actively involved in human development and the promotion of justice, peace and the promotion of inter-religious dialogue. Their ministries include the establishment of schools, hospitals, orphanages and the establishment of new Catholic communities, as well as providing pastoral care throughout the world.

Father Phillip Mayfield was ordained a PIME priest in May, 1978. He is from Detroit, Michigan. From 1978 until 1985 he worked in the United States as the Vocation Director.

From 1985-2003 he was a missionary working in Papua, New Guinea. Returning from Papua, New Guinea he worked in vocations in Wayne, NJ from 2004-2007 and then as Pastor of Holy Trinity Parish at Eastern Michigan University in Ypsilanti, Michigan from 2007-2012. He was reassigned to the U.S. Regional Headquarters in Detroit in June of 2012 as House Rector.

There will be a second collection for this cause. Please be generous to aiding this effort. Your checks should be written to St. John Nepomucene Parish.

Let us give Father Mayfield a warm welcome. May God bless his missionary efforts. Bishop Sheen used to say, "Some people give to the Missions by going; Other people go to the Missions by giving."

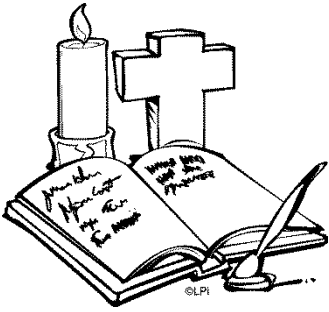
