Work will begin soon on the float for Oysterfest. Please call or text Jennifer Salas at 361 717-2593

1. Call Jennifer about work times & place.
2. Parents may bring lawn chair or beach towels for seating. Kids may need their SHS jackets as the high is 70 & low is 62 with cloudy skies.
3. All students wear red SHS t-shirts & navy bottoms AND must have Field Trip form signed and turned in. Bring individually wrapped candy for throwing and give to Mrs. Salas. She will distribute in buckets once the parade begins.
4. As is our tradition, the students whose parents work on the float will get to ride the float.
5. Youngest children ride the bus with their parent holding on to them as they stand on the seats en route.
6. 5th graders act as our Color Guard in SHS t-shirt and navy bottoms as we lead the parade with US, Texas, & Papal flags.

Saturday-Day of Parade: Decorating the float in front of the old cinema begins at 7:30am w/ float in line by 8:45am. Judging begins at 9:30am.

Parade doesn't move until 11:00am so students must be able to hang out for that long...Pick up and break-down is in front of old Cinema at 12Noon.
