## SECRET OF THE ROSARY MISSION

The Retreat will begin with the Holy Rosary at 6:15 PM, followed by the Mission from 6:30 PM to 7:30 PM.

## LENTEN REGULATIONS FROM BISHOP PROVOST

### ASH WEDNESDAY AND GOOD FRIDAY

Days of fast and abstinence. The obligation to abstain from meat binds Catholics 14 years of age and older. The obligation to fast, limiting oneself to one full meal and two lighter meals, binds Catholics from the age of 18 to 59.

The increasingly popular practice of hosting “crawfish boils” and entertainments on Good Friday is highly inappropriate. Good Friday remains an extraordinary and solemn day on which we recall the suffering and death of Our Lord Jesus Christ. Good Friday should remain a day of fasting, abstinence, prayer, penance, and interior and exterior quiet.

### ALL FRIDAYS OF LENT

Days of abstinence from meat.

### FRIDAYS OF THE YEAR OUTSIDE OF LENT

Abstaining from meat is the traditional way of observing these days of penance. Other sacrifices and penances are possible.

While the season of Lent is the primary period of Catholic penitential practices, these regulations are not intended to limit the occasions for Christian penance.
