Parish School of Religion (PSR) Registrations



Welcome back! PSR begins September 10. Registration is open now! According to the Diocese of Columbus guidelines, students wishing to receive their First Communion and First Reconciliation must attend two years of sacramental preparation (PSR or Catholic school) usually beginning during their first-grade year. Students wishing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation must attend a two-year sacramental preparation (PSR or Catholic school), usually beginning in the 6th or 7th grade.
