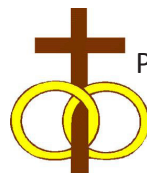

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK



Dear Saturday 4:30 p.m. Mass Parishioners,
 As you know, if you attend Saturday 4:30 p.m. Mass on a regular basis, we have been experimenting with the idea of "music-less" Masses. Phase I was a survey of 30 Saturday parishioners back in December, where more than 75% wanted to go that route. Phase II was a survey of 100 Saturday parishioners back in April, where 60% of you were in favor of a music-less Mass. Phase III will be a survey taken at the end of August after the experience of having some "music-less" Masses. Not all the Saturday Masses will be music-less, as our Folk Group will play once a month or twice a month, when there are five Saturdays in the month. Remember, this is just an experimental phase where no decisions will be made until after the August survey. We are blessed to have a variety of different music here at St. Christopher. There will be no changes to the music for our Sunday celebrations. Many folks on Saturday, however, felt the need for greater quiet time and a "quicker" Mass. A good number of summer Saturday Masses will allow this experience.
