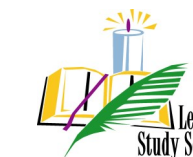

ST. PAUL SCHOLARSHIP - Applications are now available for the St. Paul Scholarship. To be eligible for this scholarship students must:

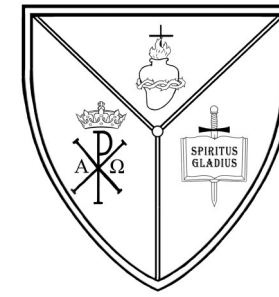


- ♦ be a graduating high school senior with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher;
