**Walk for a Cause: Support Breast Cancer and the Sue Baldwin Foundation of Door County**

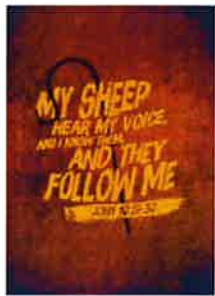
Come join in prayer and fellowship on Saturday, May 14, 2016 at 8:00-11 a.m. at
