**Veterans Day Concert of Music & Song**

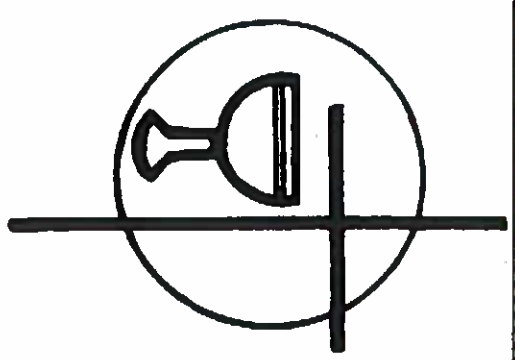
