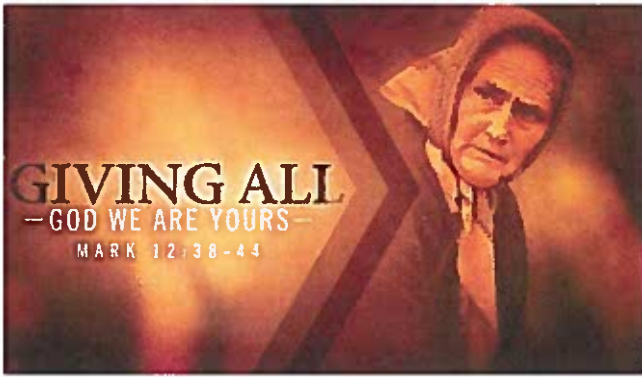

My first trip to Nicaragua was in 2012. I had no idea the impact that the people and the country would have on me. To be honest, I was not 100% comfortable. I had to meet new people, try new food, communicate with the people who don't know any English (and I knew very little Spanish), and I saw hurt and suffering more than I have ever before. I couldn't imagine being able to help with such overwhelming poverty. Thankfully, I realized that when Jesus invites us to do something new, it isn't always comfortable, but when we step outside of our comfort zones we are able to grow and step into God's greater plan for us.

And part of God's plan was for Corpus Christi to grow in relationship with the people of Nicaragua. We have been working with Catholic Sisters who run an organization called Tepeyac-Nicaragua Foundation. The goal is to bring aid and relief to the poor and distressed people located in the rural areas of Nicaragua. We have worked in a medical clinic, school, and community center. We have also put on workshops on how to treat water, keep clean, wash hands, brush teeth, cook food, treat residual water, separate garbage and recycle, create compost, keep domestic animals, etc. We have even built homes for those in need! We are so grateful for the financial donations you have given over the past 6 years.

I have been captivated by the people of Nicaragua. My life has been changed through the many relationships formed over the past 6 years. Marvin, Ervin, Mathias, Sr. Liz, Chipito, and Norma are just a few of the people I have seen the face of Christ in. We may have gone to help them, but they have forever changed my heart as well.

We can't return to Nicaragua in 2019 due to the country struggling with protests, violence, and unrest. When I heard of the violence, my first reaction was "I need to go! We need to stop the violence and help the people." I wanted to work for justice. After prayer and discussion, I was reminded that there are two aspects when helping those in need: Justice and Charity. The reality is, I can't change the situation in Nicaragua. I want to, but I can't. Instead, I can focus on that second aspect: charity. I can first and foremost pray for the people and I can donate to help those who are suffering even more due to the unrest.

I believe strongly in helping the people of Nicaragua. We have 7 themes of Social Teaching in our Church and one of them is Solidarity. We are ONE human family. Another theme is the preferential option of the poor and vulnerable... and the truth is the people of Nicaragua are poor and vulnerable so our Church teaches us we are to put them first. (Mt 25: 31-46).

Thanks for taking time to read my thoughts. I just wanted to update you all on where we are at with our brothers and sisters in Nicaragua. I could share for pages and pages about the people and the relationships we have formed. Thank you for impacting the lives of our family in Nicaragua.
