Willingness to be taught

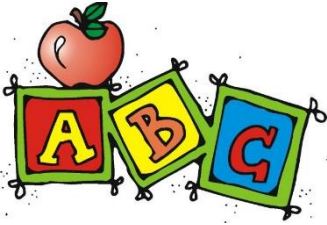
What does it look like?

The **first graders** have been working hard this last quarter to improve on all their studies. In Religion we have been learning about just how important God is in our lives. We are understanding just how important Baptism is to our Catholic faith and how it gives us a new life with Jesus. We have been looking to God and understanding He is our loving Father and wants nothing more than for us to be with Him in Heaven. We have been discussing how important the Eucharist is to us and how to discover it at Mass. We are preparing for Lent and discussing how we will try to do our part to get closer to Jesus. In Reading the students have been working on their reading comprehension and reading fluency. We just did our third round of DRA tests and I am pleased to report that every student has gone up in their reading and comprehension! They're so proud of themselves and it is helping them to be more excited about reading. In math the students have been working with base 10 models. They have been working, counting tens and ones in a variety of ways. In Social Studies the students have finished their Geography unit that helped them learn about maps, globes, bodies of water, land forms, and many types even the change in seasons. We have moved onto our Civic and Government unit and we have started learning about primary sources, what they are and how we use them today. In Science we finished up our unit on reflection and mirrors and we have moved onto freezing and melting, which seems very appropriate with the weather we are having right now. I love to see how the students are predicting, exploring and investigating what we are learning and it helps that it is very hands on so the students can dig in and love science. In Writing we have been learning to add details, conversations, characters, settings, and good beginnings to our personal narratives. Their writing is getting better and the students love telling their own stories!

Our students here at St. Paul have also been getting ready for our school's auction. We have been painting and using our creativity to make the best projects to help our school in many ways.

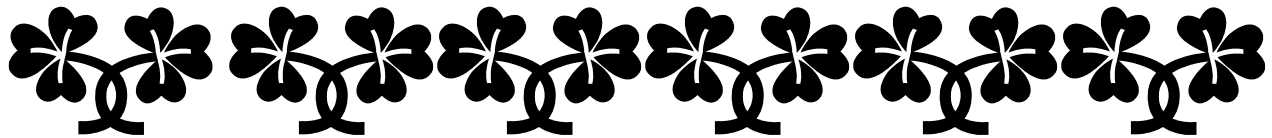
