### **Universal Prayer and Commentary**

**Sunday, May 28, 2017** 

**Focus**: Jesus' last thoughts and prayers are focused on his disciples as he prepares to face the cross.

In preparing his disciples for when he will no longer be with them, Jesus encourages them by prayer. This is his hour of glorification, but it is equally their hour too. While Jesus is ready to embrace the work of redemption, he knows his disciples will have their faith shaken. So his prayer reassures them that they will share his glory because they already belong to him by faith.

Liturgy of the Word: The first reading from Acts recalls how after the Ascension, the disciples return to Jerusalem and gather together in continuous prayer as they await the coming of the Holy Spirt. The second reading reminds us that when we suffer, we share in the sufferings of Christ. In the Gospel, taken from the farewell discourse, Jesus prays from his disciples as the time for his glorification draws near.
