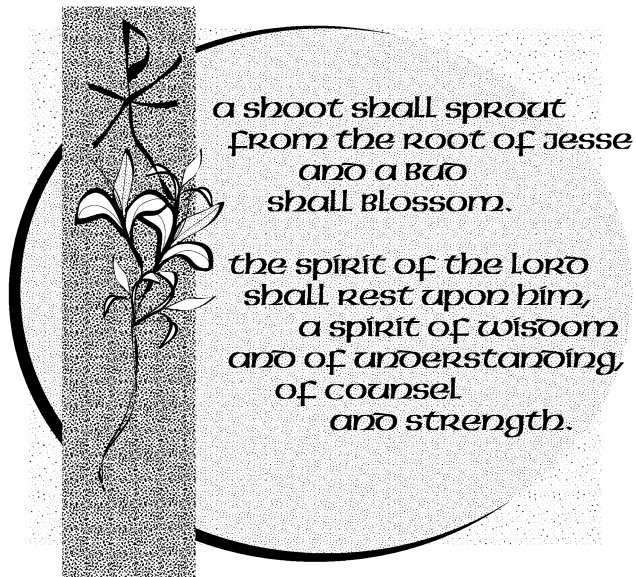


**Second Sunday of Advent

Reflection on the Scriptures

"The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him." —Isaiah 11:2

Imagine a world without violence, injustice, tragedy, "harm or ruin" (Isaiah 11:9). Imagine a world where everyone knows the Lord deeply and lives and loves accordingly (see Isaiah 11:9). This is the kind of world that the Holy Spirit is re-creating at this very moment (Psalm 104:30 Get out of the "culture of death" (Pope St. John Paul II). Be a part of the "new civilization of love" (Blessed Pope Paul VI). Renew your Baptism and Confirmation. Be immersed in the Holy Spirit and fire (Matthew 3:11). May the Spirit of the Lord rest upon you: "a Spirit of wisdom and of understanding, a Spirit of counsel and of strength, a Spirit of knowledge and of fear of the Lord" (Isaiah 11:2).
