Confirmandi and Sponsors will have a practice next Sunday, Oct. 15th at 3:00pm.

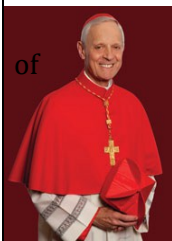
